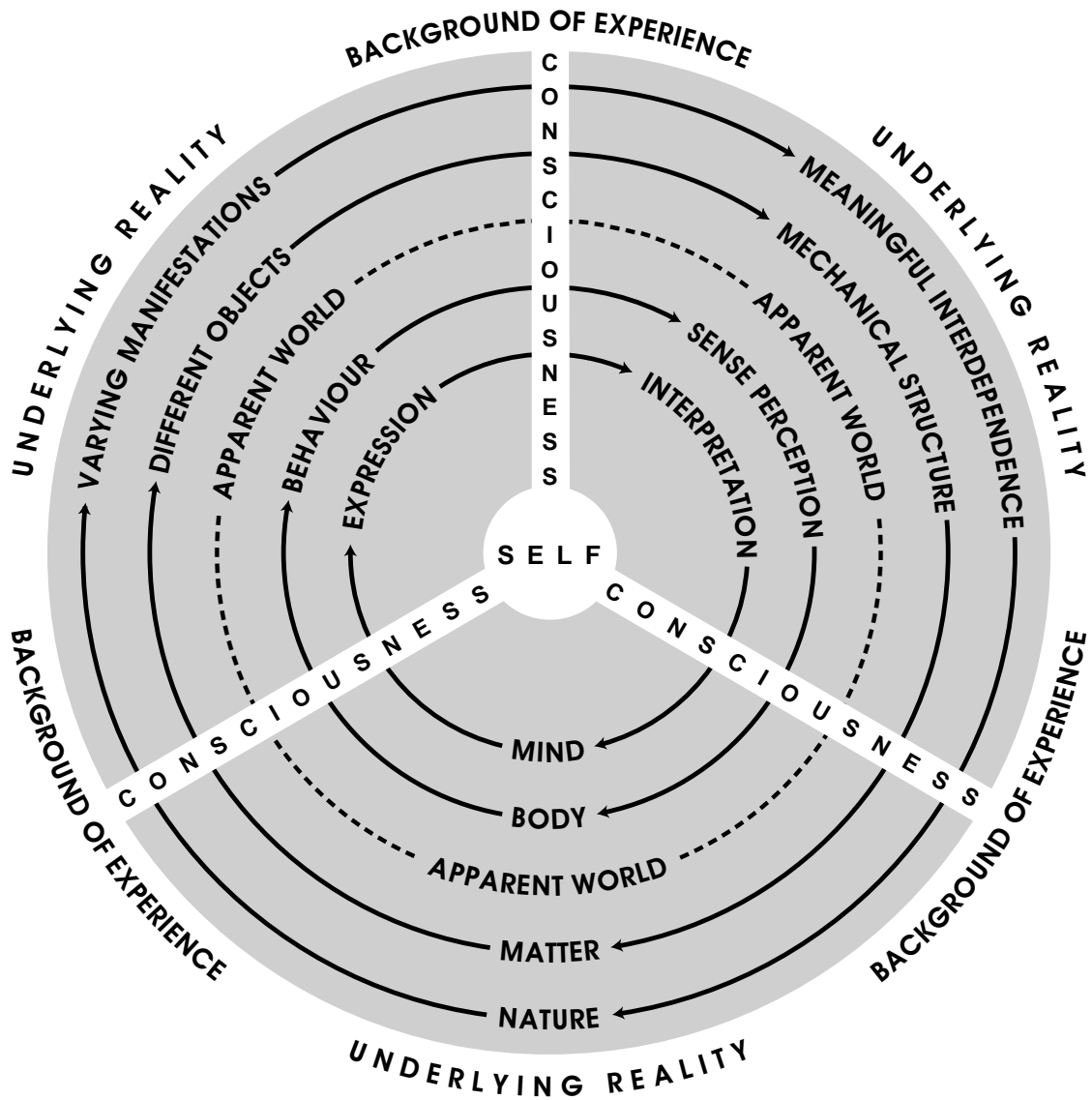


FIVE ELEMENTS
